

Privacy Policy

We are committed to helping you make the most of your free time on the Internet with a trusted environment. This privacy policy discloses how we collect, protect, use and share information gathered about you. We hope that this disclosure will help you increase your confidence in our site and enhance your experience on the Internet.

Types of information we collect and how we collect it.

The majority of the product and service information posted on our site is offered without our collecting any personally identifiable information from you. You can surf the website and view much of our content anonymously.

Information You Provide

There are a few activities on our site where the collection of personally identifiable information is necessary. Those activities include requesting a catalog or other information. We do not market to or knowingly collect information from children. Therefore our customer information does not apply to anyone under thirteen years of age.

When personally identifiable information is collected, you will know because you will have to fill out a form. For most activities, we collect information such as your name, e-mail address, street address, zip code, birth date, RV Type, billing address and your phone number.

Information collected from you with technology

Our site will collect some information about you using technology, so it may not be readily apparent to you that it is being collected. For instance, when you come to our site your IP address is collected so that we know where to send information you are requesting. An IP address is often associated with the place from which you enter the Internet like your ISP (Internet Service Provider), your company, or your university. This information is not personally identifiable. Our Site uses information collected through technology to make our site more interesting and useful to you. We normally don't combine this type of information with personally identifiable information. However, we will combine this information with personally identifiable information to identify a visitor in order to enforce compliance with our house rules or terms of service, site, users, or others.

Descriptions of Cookies, and how we use them

Cookies are pieces of information that a Web site send to your computer while you are viewing the Web site. These pieces of information allow the Web site to remember important information that will make your use of those sites more useful. Our site will use cookies for a variety of purposes.

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through you browser (like Netscape Navigator or Internet Explorer) settings. Each browser is a little different, so look at your

browser's Help menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies. If you turn cookies off, you won't have access to many of our features that make your web experience more efficient.

How We Use the Personally Identifiable Information that We Collect

We use personally identifiable information in a limited number of ways. We use the information to complete transactions. For instance, we use your information to process your request, or if you contact us for help we will use the information to contact you. Information we collect is used to send you e-mail updates related to clubs, products and services and newsletters about our resort.

Who We Share our Information With

One of the most valuable assets of our business is you. We aren't in the business of selling information about our users. We will also share information for security reasons.

We will give out personal information as required by law, for example, to comply with a court order or subpoena; to enforce our Terms of Service, or site or game rules; or to protect the safety and security of users and our site.

Sometimes we hire companies to help us deliver products or services, like a shipping company that delivers a package. In those instances, we need to share your information with them. These companies are basically "standing in our shoes", and they are allowed to use the information only to deliver the product or service.

On occasion, we offer promotions. In addition, we will occasionally send e-mail promotions out to our users on behalf of third-party sponsors to conduct promotions regarding lifestyle-related products or services. Again, we only send these promotions to you if we have your permission

Content Providers

Sometimes we provide content that is created by a third-party Web site. In some instances the third-party sites will collect information in order to facilitate the transaction or to make the use of their content more productive and efficient. In these circumstances the information collected is shared between our third-party sponsors and us. We supply links to web sites for your convenience. We allow on our sites only those companies that have their own privacy policy. Once you've clicked on a link and have left our site, our privacy policy no longer applies. You must read the privacy policy of the linked web site to see how your personal information will be handled.

Purchase or Sale of Businesses

Online business is still in a very early stage and are changing and evolving rapidly. As we continually look for ways to improve our business, we may buy or sell a company. If we buy or sell a business, the names collected will likely be transferred as a part of the sale. Information about registrants will be used in the aggregate. However, if we buy a business, we will honor the requests that customers made of

that business regarding e-mail communications. In the event that we sell a business, we will do everything in our power to ensure that the e-mail communications requests you made of us are honored.

Choices You Have About Our Collecting, Using, and Sharing Your Information

It is possible for you to use much of our site without giving us any personally identifiable information. When you do register with us or give us personally identifiable information, you will have an opportunity to limit e-mail communications from us. The Type of Security We Provide

The importance of security for all personally identifiable information associated with our users is of utmost concern to us. We take technical, contractual, administrative, and physical security steps to protect all visitors' information.
